

POST-TRAUMATIC ACUTE PANCREATITIS CLINICAL-IMAGISTIC CORRELATIONS

Abstract: *There is presented the case of an 8-year old patient who, after an intense abdominal traumatism, develops an acute pancreatitis with imagistic pattern of peripancreatic spindles (collections) and pancreatic pseudocyst, with favorable evolution only under conservatory treatment. The aim of the present case study arose from the severity of the affection (of the post-traumatic acute pancreatitis), from the fact that this affection is extremely rare, as well from the favorable evolution of the case.*
