HEPATOCARCINOMA WITH INVASION OF RIGHT SUPRA-HEPATIC VEIN – CASE STUDY –

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Abstract: The present article presents the case of a patient with hepatic cirrhosis who, on imagistic basis (echography and computerized tomography examination) was diagnosed with invasive hepatocarcinoma in the right supra-hepatic vein. The particularity of this case consists in the fact that the tumour extension, invasion, occurs in a supra-hepatic vein and not in one of the branches of the portal vein as it is more frequently met in practice.
