## VARIATION AND CREATION IN THE INTERPRETATION OF SONG

Abstract: The term "musical variation" refers to the alteration process of a unit of the musical discourse (motif, phrase, period, harmonic structure, theme, section, etc.). The variation is the nucleus of popular music development. This places them at the core of the song's creation process.
