(Dynamics in music - importance and ways of expression)

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Abstract: This study aims at emphasizing the importance of musical dynamics in the performance and study of a choral score. Moreover, it tackles the ways of expression, those means and tools the conductor uses to communicate their intentions to the ensemble, such as pronation – to enhance the musical dynamics, and its reverse, supination – to fade out the sonority.
